3. Each team will be given an answer sheet as to where they will write their answers. The sheet will be turned into the scorer at the end of trivia.
4. There are 19 multiple choice questions that are each worth 2 points. If you get the question right, you gain +2points. If you get the question wrong, you do not lose points.
5. There is 1 bonus question worth 3points. If you get the question right, you gain +3points. If you get the question wrong, you lose -3points. You are not required to answer the question.
6. In the event that a tie-breaker is needed, there is a question listed at the end of the game. It is worth one point.
7. Each team is allotted 30 seconds per multiple choice question and fill in the blank question and 60 seconds for the tie breaker. There is a 5 second countdown for every question.
8. An answer key to the multiple choice questions and the bonus question are listed in a separate document. The scorer will add up points and determine if the tie breaker is needed.
9. Answers for the tie breaker need to be turned into the scorer before the 60 seconds is up or they will not be counted. The scorer will judge the tie breaker at their discretion.
