

# How to Draw a Gorilla

**1.** Sketch 3 circles to create the head and back.

Tip: Make the head circle extra tall and skinny.



**2.** Add circles to create the arms, legs, hands, and feet.



**3.** Draw a dark line from the chin all the way to the edge of the back leg.



**4.** Add in the legs, including the same flares of fur that the arms have.

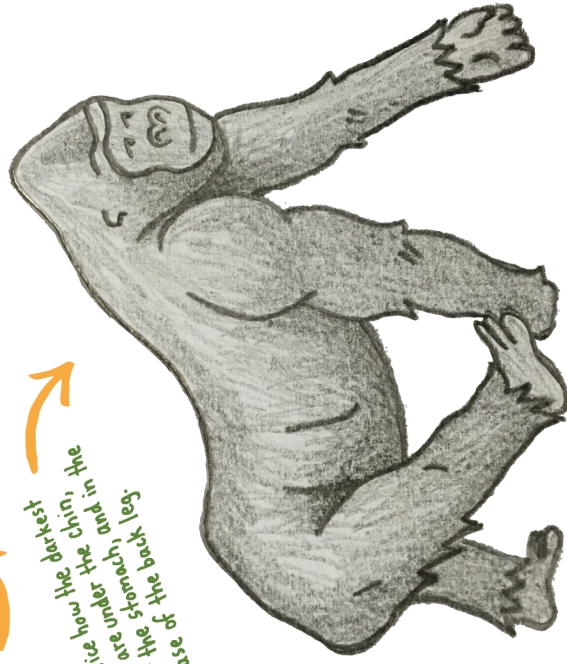


**5.**

Add in the arms, creating small flares of fur at the joints and wrists.

Tip: Leave a space on the gorilla's right arm for its back foot.

Tip: The gorilla's nostrils and eyes are both shaped like a pair of quotation marks.



**6.** Draw the gorilla's hands and feet.

**7.**

Add in the remaining features, including the facial features and the small fur marks at the knees and elbows.



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**8.** Shade in the fur to add depth to the gorilla's body.

Tip: Notice how the darkest crease of the back leg, under the stomach, and in the chin, are under the darkest.
